



Greetings and welcome to Fretz TC 2023 Summer Camps!

PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE CONTENTS OF THIS LETTER

Due to the ever growing number of campers in our Summer Camps at Fretz, we have provided a little bit of information we think you should know about.

From checking in to checking out, your camper's safety is first and foremost concern. To help us with this, here is some information we want you to know ahead of time:

MONDAY CHECK-IN will begin at 8:30 am at main entrance

Your child will receive a name tag and a wristband for the camp they are enrolled in. Campers are expected to bring a tennis racket to camps. If your child does not have a tennis racquet, you are welcome to stop by the pro-shop and purchase one from our large selection of affordable junior racquets. After check-in they will be directed where to sit and wait for Coaches and counselors introduction and instructions. **After Monday, check in is at 8:45.** If your child is dropped off before then, you will be charged \$15 for early drop off each day. Pick up times vary for each camp. If your child is picked up more than 15 minutes after their camp ends, you will also be charged a \$15 late pick up fee each day.

Check Out: All Campers must be signed out by an adult. We cannot release children without Mom or Dad's signature. This is for the safety of your child and we apologize if this is an inconvenience. If someone other than the person dropping off your child is picking them up, we will need a note signed by the parent at the sign in that morning. No exceptions.

Tennis Only Campers - Please make sure your child is wearing sunscreen each day and brings a water jug (something more substantial than a bottle). A hat or visor is also helpful. Proper shoes (non-marking soles) are mandatory and no jeans please. It is very hot on the tennis courts and it is important to have your child dressed appropriately for the heat. It is also a good idea to have all items labeled with your child's name in case something is left behind. In the event of rain, Tennis Camp will be cancelled. **We will post on our social media accounts if we cancel Tennis Camps @ Fretz Tennis Center**

We do not post rain outs on our website.

All Day Campers and Half Day Campers (9am-1pm) – The first part of your camp is spent on the tennis courts. Please make sure your child is wearing sunscreen each day

and brings a water jug (something more substantial than a bottle). A hat or visor is also helpful. Proper shoes (non-marking soles) are mandatory and no jeans please. It is very hot on the tennis courts and it is important to have your child dressed appropriately for the heat. If your child is enrolled in the All Day Camp, they will also need to come with a swimsuit, towel, sandals, additional sunscreen for the pool and a change of clothing for after swimming. It is a good idea to have all items labeled with your child's name in case something is left behind.

In the Event of Rain: If it should rain, All camps will be cancelled. We try our best to make a decision about an hour before check-in starts. Please keep in mind that weather could be unpredictable but our priority will always be to keep the camps on for our students and save the parents from a drive back to the tennis center.

All Day and Half Day (9am-1pm) Camp Lunch: Campers will need to bring their own lunch, lunch will be held after tennis. We do offer snacks for purchase at the snack bar in the pro-shop (Mostly healthier options), however you may want to pack your camper enough snacks for the day as well.

Swimming: Swimming will be at The Cove Aquatic Center at Fretz Park. Please note that this portion of the Full Day camps is not a swimming class. We take our campers to the aquatic center to cool down and enjoy all the water activities at the aquatic center after hours of playing tennis and other sports in the heat. Only campers 7 and up will be allowed to sign up for the all day camps and swimming. No exceptions. Our team of counselors will be at the aquatic center and monitoring campers at all times. Parents are not allowed to pick up campers from the aquatic center and all campers must check-out at the front desk inside the pro-shop.

Movie Time: Movie time is held after swimming. The majority of our campers are pretty exhausted during this time and are happy to relax after a long day of tennis, swimming and sports. The movie chosen is always rated PG. If your child is not interested in the movie, we have a variety of board games and card games for them to enjoy during this time, as well. If staff and courts are available, more tennis may also be an option.

Please note: We do have drinks and snacks for purchase in the Pro Shop. Many parents often put a few dollars on their child's account for these items. It is best not to send your child with cash as this is often lost or misplaced during the day.

***** Our lost and found will be on display every Monday upon camp check in. After Monday, all unclaimed items will be donated.***
